- Starting point at Meramec River Access, HWY 8 37.950289, -91.507897
- Event will not be timed, however the winner shall be toasted with the finest of hopped beverages.
- We will not write down finishing order. If you wanna know your time, wear a watch.
- There are no categories to make any particular demographic feel special.
- Participants shall complete two 25-mile gravel circuits. Or one if you're not feelin' it.
- The route is subject to change depending on river levels.
- If you wanna race, then race. If you wanna just ride, that's cool too. Race it Ride it Tour it.
- Fake racing rules will be strictly enforced, whatever that means.
- Participants may stop at vehicles after one circuit to grab some piggy snacks.
- Course will be well marked with arrows on the ground prior to intersections.
- There is no pavement on this ride except for the last ¼ mile, unless we have to ride the high water route.
- There are at least two Category 4 climbs per lap. There are NO flat roads.
- There's a bunch of low-water slabs, but we're gonna stay away from the sketchy ones.
- The course is open to vehicular traffic, although you are not likely to see much. Ride Right!
- Take a sec to enjoy the views in the upper Meramec valley. It's pretty easy on the eyes.

- In the event of shitty weather or high water, event may be postponed. Oh well,, it's January.
- Restrooms are available at the parking area. Drinking water is not.
